ENGINEERING TESTING



- · Last Sunday, Members of the Engineering Team carried out RF Radio Testing, in preparation for the upcoming Chelmsford Marathon, which is on Sunday 15th October
- We deployed 2x Temporary Talk-Through/Crossband Repeaters, linking into our Cascade RF Network at Chelmsford
- Additionally, we performed range testing of APRS on 2m VHF, utilizing our recently installed APRS Digipeater, which we can deploy on an as required basis.
- The testing was successful and showed that APRS Coverage and RF Voice Communications were reliable from a Hand Portable Radio, using our Network design
